Ministry Resource Process

Fourth, organize the resource on the website or in a shared library.

Fifth, update the resource as programs grow, laws change, or ministry needs evolve.

This process helps ensure that resources remain helpful, accurate, and aligned with the ministry's purpose.

Resource Stewardship and Responsibility

Ministries of Love should handle all resources with care and responsibility. Any forms that collect personal information should protect privacy and only request information that is necessary. Resources should be respectful, inclusive, and written in a way that honors the people being served.

Wedding-related resources should encourage ministers and couples to follow local marriage laws, including license requirements and filing responsibilities.
